What is Participatory Budget?

Participatory budgeting (PB) is a democratic process in which community members directly decide how to spend part of a public budget. PB gives ordinary people real decision-making power over real money.

How much money will be available in the 10th Ward Participatory Budget? \$1 Million

What will the money be used for? Strictly for infrastructure; neighborhood beautification, updating lights, repaving streets, fixing the parks, etc. What can the money NOT be used for? It cannot be used to build a community organization, pay for soccer uniforms, hire youth, programming, etc. * Eligible projects must: 1. be located in the 10th Ward, 2. benefit the community, 3. be a capital improvement.
